 impact in terms of activity reduction - patient non attendance / patient cancellation, demonstrated from 14.03.20 onwards

Waiting Lists:

- decrease in activity will impact waiting lists
- reduction in referrals from GPs, may lead to late diagnosis with clear implications for subsequent care / management requirements

Finance:

- projected 0.9% deficit in 2020, assuming COVID-19 impact and other outstanding funding issues resolved
- significant decrease in private patient income noted

HR:

- recruitment increase across all RCSI Hospital Group sites
- March absenteeism 7.6%

Designation of Trauma Services

- no notification of outcome received to date.

Sláintecare (RICO's)

an internal exercise has commenced with regard to design of new R.I.C.O,

COVID-19:

- on site testing for COVID-19 has been established in all RCSI Hospital Group sites with a 24 hour turn around for results
- a post COVID-19 pathway has been formulated

Nursing Home Support:

- RCSI Hospital Group have put in place support systems to approximately 30 nursing homes with in its catchment area
- this has included suppling medical, nursing, equipment and testing support when required

Private Hospitals:

- pathways with Bons Secours / Hermitage Private Hospitals and Beaumont / Connolly Hospitals have been established
- intermediate and non-complex surgeries being undertake in these hospitals complex surgeries largely remain in existing institutions
