CLINICAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS 2024

The Office of the Chief Director Of Nursing & Midwifery, HSE Dublin & North East will award 5 Clinical Bursaries each to the value of €5,000. The scholarship is open to registered Nurses and Midwives working in HSE Dublin & North East Hospital Region, in the direct provision of health care, across all practice settings.

The bursary will support a publication in a peer reviewed professional journal relating to:

- clinical research findings
- clinical audit findings or
- clinical quality improvements

Successful applicants must commit to publication within 1 year of receiving the Scholarship Award.

Scholarship bursary can be used to support the research publication, for example:

- Travel subsistence
- Ongoing educational support or
- Backfill of work hours to release time to conduct research (will need to be approved by line manager).
- Expenditure incurred must be compliant with HSE National Financial Regulations and tax compliance.

Line managers approval and signature must be attained.

Word Count: Max. 1000 words

Successful candidates will be offered mentorship from the Chief Director of Nursing and Midwifery office and will include being allocated a clinical and academic mentor to support a successful outcome of publication
